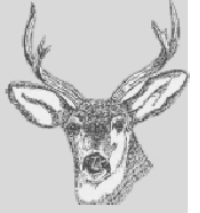

Infants looking back at last week

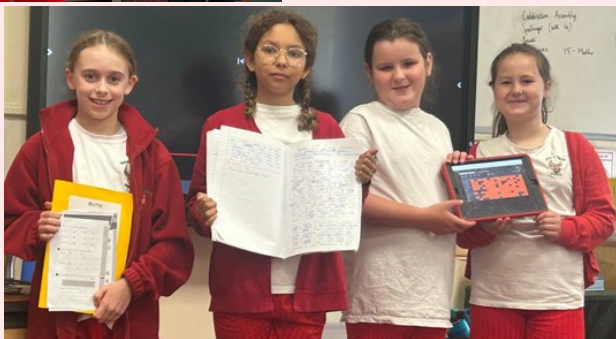

Lower Juniors looking back at last week

This week, in Science we used fizzy drinks to find out if gases weigh anything. They had to measure the drinks when they were fizzy, then make them flat and measure again to see what the difference was. In Maths and Literacy, the children have worked hard on their end of term assessments and should be extremely proud of their achievements. In Art, the children put the finishing touches to the vases they have been creating using a scraffito technique with black acrylic paint and wax crayons to create a Greek vase design, depicting an Olympic sport. The results are wonderful.
