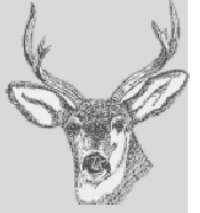

### Infants looking back at last week

We shared the story 'Oi! Get Off Our Train' and remembered the reasons all the different animals wanted to board the train before adding our own setting for the train to visit identifying why it would stop there. 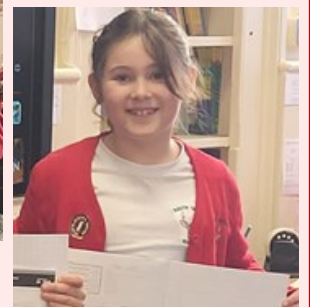
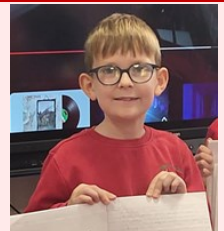
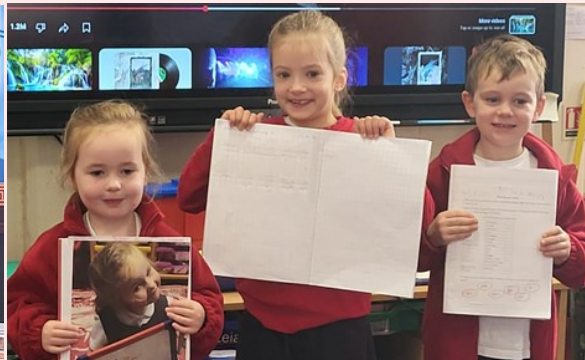
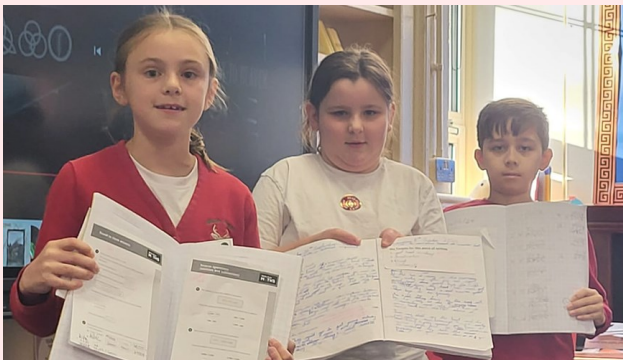
### Juniors looking back at last week

Y5/6 pupils have been busy finishing their narratives about Thom going to Bergen and leaving Hildi. They used some great descriptions and worked well to write in the style of Rachael Lindsay. Y3/4 planned and wrote a diary entry as if they were Thom from the Warrior Troll whilst practising their handwriting. In Science Y5/6 used coloured filters looking through them to see how they affect the colour of objects. Y3/4 used their image search skills to find specific types of image for their computing journals. All of the juniors have worked with each other to share their research about the Anglo-Saxons before designing and making posters to showcase their knowledge.

### Juniors looking forward to next week

Y5/6 will look at AI and fake news in computing. They will create storyboards for short videos. In Literacy pupils will write poetry about a Viking village using their very best descriptions. They will look at shadows in Science and create their own shadow puppets. Y3/4 will find out what happened to Thom on his trip to Bergen and will write a postcard from there as if they were Thom. If anyone can bring in examples of postcards they have received that would be great. In maths, they will continue their unit on addition and subtraction. Pupils will make musical instruments in science on Tuesday—please bring in any junk modelling type equipment they would like to use as what we have in school is a bit limited!
