Reception will find out the poet Edward Lear and look at nonsense poems. In Maths they will add on one and two more to any number up to twenty and form their own number sentence.

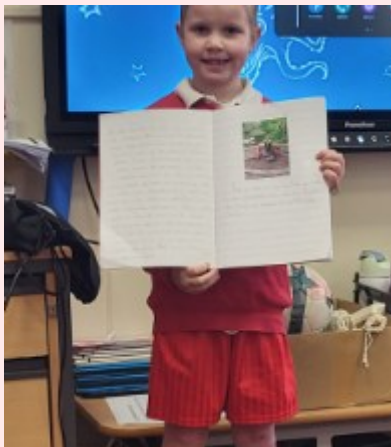
### Juniors looking back at last week
