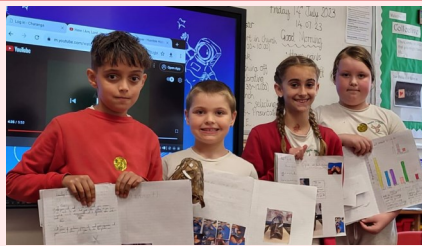
### Infants looking back at last week
